






CTCI Board Meeting Highlights Sept. 19, 2025 ~ Updated

Member Renewals: Garrett Shropshire presented membership renewals through the end of 2024. Last year (12/31/2024), we ended up with 3,601 active members. Between January and August of 2025, we gained 112 New Members. In addition, we gained 16 members who returned to CTCI from prior years (before 2024). As of 8/30/2025, we are now at 3,183 active members. We are nearing the end of the last "follow-up" Renewal Cycle. At this point, we have 496 Members who have not renewed. Of that total, we have only received 61 notices of dropouts.

Co-Sharing of Membership: Garrett praised many of the chapters that have already sent in their chapter membership rosters. This co-marketing effort is to persuade all Non-CTCI members, part of a chapter, to join the membership of CTCI. We have already reached out to over 200 prospects who are current members of a chapter.

Cost Saving Ideas: We continue to include savings from the Early Bird changes, Storage changes, credit card processing, and reduced Office hours. We are excited by positive operating statements. At this point, we are continuing to show better than our financial plan.





CTCI Board Meeting Highlights Sept. 19, 2025 ~ Updated

Office Activity: Garrett reported on Invoice and Merchandise sales. For 2025, CTCI has had over \$8,797.95 in Merchandise Sales, which is slightly less than last year. In addition, 31 requests have been made for factory invoices.

2025 Joint Thunderbird Convention Preliminary Report: Brian Carron provided an initial update on the 2025 Convention (Grapevine, TX) that just wrapped up. The Joint Convention had 336 registrants and 109 cars on the "show field." There were 61 "first timers," with participation from 28 states as well as Sweden. Brian also mentioned that we received donations from 16 chapters of both VTCI and CTCI. In addition to the many chapters, we received tremendous support from our vendor, sponsors, advertisers, and volunteers.

Future Considerations for Joint Thunderbird Events: President Bob Bly, who, along with Brian Carron, is one of CTCI's representatives to The Thunderbird Owners Alliance, reported on the Joint activities. Bob stated that we are proud to partner in the Joint Convention (VTCI & CTCI) that took place last weekend in Grapevine, TX. Our many thanks go to Brian Carron for his leadership in bringing the Convention to fruition. Overall, the Joint Convention was well received by both clubs, and while there are still a few items to iron out, the Joint Convention was a positive experience for most of the participants.

To expand those efforts, we also invited Bart Bartasavich (President of ITC) to join VTCI and CTCI on a Zoom call to continue our discussions on future joint events. Unfortunately, Bart was unable to participate. There is genuine interest within both CTCI and VTCI members to expand this partnership, and we are working on future events with or without ITC involvement. We have left an open invitation for Bart (and ITC) to be included in future discussions. In the meantime, we are moving forward with VTCI on upcoming activities.

New Format for Future Conventions and Shows: The Board continued their discussions on how to improve future CTCI Conventions. The Board is looking at different models for future conventions that includes adjusting "Convention - Judging - Member Meeting" format. More information will be forthcoming.
