Board of Directors Meeting Highlights Video Conference May 15, 2026

Treasurer's Report: John Kledis is currently working on the first quarter financials and should have them ready for the next meeting. At this point, it is too early in the renewal cycle to understand the membership renewal income. He discussed that he reviewed the 2026 CTCI membership revenue, and it looks like we are near break-even. He stated that he is pleased with the financial shape of the Club. John stressed that we need to continue to control overhead expenses and increase membership for the balance of 2026.

Member Renewals: Garrett Shropshire, through the Office Activity Report, documented member renewals. Garrett shared that Last year (12/31/2025), we ended up with 3,271 active members. Between January and April of 2026, we gained 59 new members. In addition, we gained 15 members who returned to CTCI from prior years (before 2025). As of 4/28/2026, we are now at 2,779 active members. We are nearing the end of the regular renewal period. We are sending reminders to those missing members. At this point, we have 511 members who have not renewed. Of that total, we have only received 55 notices of dropouts.

2026 Member Renewal Marketing Plan: Garrett outlined that three different chapters were sent CTCI materials for shows and events. He will continue to send materials to chapters to support and encourage membership in CTCI. The Board discussed and is creating recommendations for evaluating direct financial support requests. A chapter request for support is now located on the CTCI website.

Office Activity: The CTCI Activity Report & stats for the Factory Invoices and Merchandise Sales for the whole year of 2025 and year to date for 2026 are included for your review. We have assisted the invoice committee in processing 22 Invoice requests so far in 2026, which is up from 16 at the same time last year. Merchandise sales for the year to date are at \$6,336.85. We are UP in merchandise sales from the same period in 2025. In addition, since we are NOT adding to the inventory, our balance sheet for the store continues to get better (turning inventory into cash).

Joint Convention 2026: The CTCI Board discussed the current progress of the 2026 Joint (TOA) Convention. At this point, only the hotel contract has been finalized. The registration page on the Website is now up and functional. All events have now been planned. The Committee will work over the next few weeks to finalize many of these details.

Nominating Committee: The Nominating Committee proposed, and the Board approved, improved procedures to help the membership gain a clearer understanding of each candidate's background and qualifications to assist the CTCI Board.

The next board meeting is set for July 17, 2026, at 10:00 AM Central
